The **Helena Citizens' Council** is an arm of city government comprised of representatives from each of the seven neighborhood districts. The group makes recommendations to the City Commission regarding budget and development issues and fields concerns from individual residents. The organization also seeks to inform Helena residents of policy changes at the city level that could affect resident's quality of life.

The **camera operator** will be responsible for the operation of a video camera during the HCC's monthly meeting. This camera is a basic camcorder mounted on a tripod. It operates similar to a home video camera.

Qualifications:

- The volunteer does not need prior experience running video cameras. A brief training prior to the first filming will be given.
- The volunteer should have the ability to follow camera directions given over a headset.

Conditions:

- Starts: January, 2010.
- Schedule: The fourth Wednesday of each month from 7:00 PM until 9:00 PM. The volunteer will be notified of any schedule changes at least a month in advance. The meetings are held at the City/County Building at 316 N. Park Ave.
- Ends: Ongoing.
