

HCC Recommendation

DATE: September 24, 2003

TOPIC: Buildings to be Numbered

SUMMARY: Throughout the city, many households and businesses fail to adequately display their street address as required by city code Title 7, Chapter 6, Section 1 (7-6-1) – Buildings to be Numbered. RECOMMENDATION: City staff should identify buildings not complying with city code and issue warnings for compliance as outlined in 7-6-3 Refusal to Number.
